Dit is vir die Redaksie van die *HTS Teologiese Studies* 'n besondere voorreg om in hierdie jubileumjaar van die Universiteit van Pretoria, 'n feesuitgawe aan Prof dr C R de Beer, viserektor en onder andere verantwoordelik vir die Fakulteit van Teologie, op te dra.

Prof De Beer se betrokkenheid by die Fakulteit dateer terug tot Junie 1995 toe hy die verantwoordelike viserektor vir die destydse twee Fakulteite van Teologie geword het. It is a great honour for the Editorial Board of *HTS Theological Studies* to dedicate this celebratory edition of the journal to Professor C R de Beer, the Vice-Rector, who is, *inter alia*, responsible for the Faculty of Theology, in this jubilee year of the University of Pretoria.

Professor De Beer's involvement with the Faculty dates back to June 1995, when he was appointed the vice-rector responsible for the then two Faculties of Theology.
